I wrote the following to Tracey Marks, MD, a forensic psychiatrist: As your subspecialty is forensic psychiatry, I am curious if you have ever evaluated someone for a court who use wheelchair. Jails and prisons are not accommodating for people with disabilities. At St. Elizabeths, I was not permitted to use my powerchair or choose to use a forward-facing walker when I was on a transitional/non-intensive unit. It is a wonder I never developed any sort of pressure ulcers. But I always transferred or got up and move to try to prevent that. If you read through my chart, you would think they were treating bipolar disorder. I love good pharmacological management of bipolar disorder, but all that happen was my inner anxiety dialogue sort of quieted, and I flattened my affect when needed with clinicians in order to avoid mistreatment or pathologization. I'm curious: in forensic settings, whom do you consider to be your primary patient and your primary responsibility, even if you are paid by a criminal-defendant team or prosecution? Do you look to see that they are receiving proper treatment for other medical issues, besides mental status exam/competency testing?

Linda POmeroy, VR counsellor, as you are a civil servant in Washington, I found that a recent salary of yours was \$72,000! I know civil servants are usually paid on the first and the tenth. What do you really wanna buy on the first and tenth? When do you pay your rent or mortgage? How much is your rent or mortgage? When do you buy your food? How much do you spend on groceries versus cat food? How many times do your cats eat a day? Do your cats contribute in-kind maintenance and support income, or do you declare them as dependents? Or are they business partners? Are your FICA taxes (Social Security and Medicare) withheld for you, or do you save them and pay them yourself? How does it feel to be on the receiving end of questions like this? Do you think they're appropriate? If not, why is it appropriate when you do it? Talk to you tomorrow!!!!!!!!!!!!
